Spring is Around the Corner

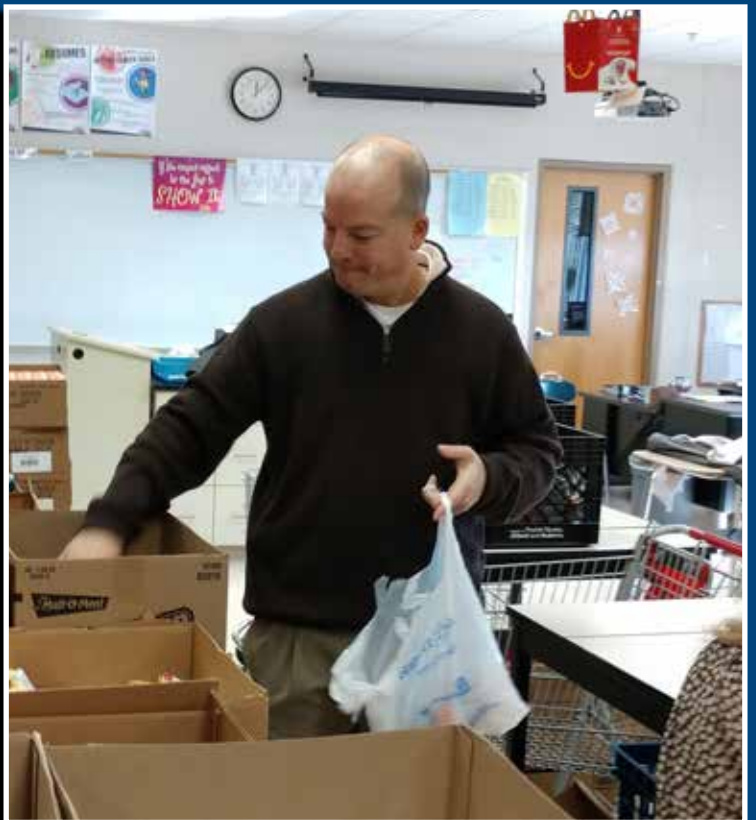
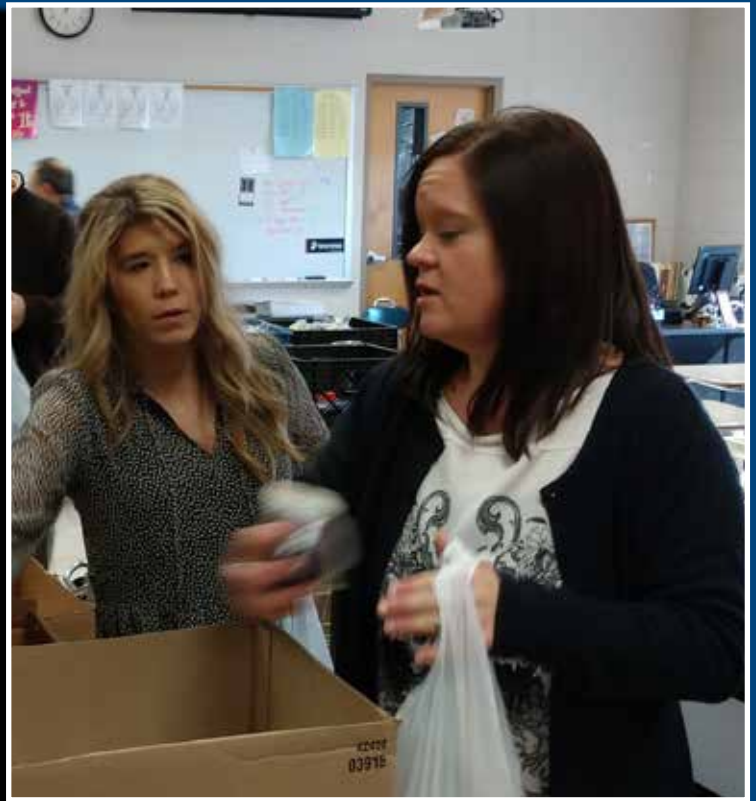
